## Creating a question

Creating a question is done by selecting New Question. New questions can be filled with the question description, the question type, and providing the image location

## Creating an answer

Just like creating a question, adding a new answer is done by selecting New Answer. Answers are associated with questions however. So when creating a new answer, a dropdown allows the selection of the question to which the answer is matched

## Listing Questions or Answer

The options "List Questions" and "List Answers" gives the ability to view all of the created questions (or answers), along with their related information. Here is a sample screenshot below:

As one can see, along with ID and Name information, question/answer data includes the goal image id. In addition, a set of options exist to view, edit and delete a specific question (or a specific answer). Selecting "view" on a question/answer row provides the perspective that an end-user would see. As mentioned above, since Answers are linked to question, a question ID appears in the listing of Answers
